



Easier-than-ever flood risk reports for property owners

LIVE OAK, FLA, March 3, 2016 — The Suwannee River Water Management District (District) has unveiled an updated version of its flood risk reporting interactive online map. The online mapping site is popular among property owners and realtors for both flood risk reports and for the flood-elevation estimates needed for septic-tank permits.

The updated site is faster and easier to use, thanks to the latest web technologies. The menus are simplified and now the site offers one-click flood risk reports. Among the enhancements requested by users, the system now provides county-specific property-information, which in turn saves time by ensuring that properties are in each county's required format.
