Governor Scott reappoints Quincey and Jones to SRWMD Board

LIVE OAK, FL, August 3, 2016 – Governor Rick Scott announced the reappointments of Don Quincey Jr. and Gary Jones to the Suwannee River Water Management District (District) Governing Board.

Mr. Quincey is reappointed for a term beginning August 2, 2016 and ending March 1, 2020. He is presently the Chair of the Governing Board and represents the Lower Suwannee Basin.

Mr. Quincey resides in Chiefland and is the owner of Quincey Cattle Company. He also currently serves as the vice president of Region II for the National Cattleman's Beef Association and previously served as the president of the Florida Cattleman's Association. Mr. Quincey received his associates degree from Santa Fe Community College.

Governor Scott also announced the reappointment of Mr. Gary Jones to the District Governing Board. Mr. Jones is reappointed for a term beginning August 2, 2016 and ending March 1, 2020.

Mr. Jones resides in Old Town and is currently a self-employed farmer with Jones Farms. He also serves as an athletic coach with the Dixie County School Board. Previously, Mr. Jones was a state law enforcement officer and in the Florida Marine Patrol. Mr. Jones received his associates degree from Lake City Community College. He is reappointed for a term beginning August 2, 2016 and ending March 1, 2020.

The appointments are subject to confirmation by the Florida Senate.
