District lands closed for public use

LIVE OAK, FL September 7, 2016 – Due to flooding and unsafe conditions created by Hurricane Hermine several roads within Suwannee River Water Management District lands are closed.

District tracts and road closures include:

Columbia County – the entire Gar Pond,

Dixie County – Steinhatchee Rise tract, Steinhatchee Springs tract,

Hamilton County – Swift Creek tract, Jennings Bluff tract,

Jefferson County – Goose Pasture tract,

Lafayette County – McCall's Chapel Grade road in Mallory Swamp,
Steinhatchee Springs tract,

Levy County – Devil's Hammock tract,

Taylor County – Steinhatchee Springs tract and Steinhatchee Falls tract.

For your safety, do not attempt to drive through water standing or flowing across roads due to wash outs. Turn around.
